CONTEST SCHEDULE:

Friday will be registration and optional test flying day starting around 9AM. A frequency board will be available and must be used.

Saturday Registration/Check in time is 8:00 AM. Pilots' meeting is at 8:30 AM. First group will fly at 9:00 AM.

Flying will be in groups of not more than 10 pilots. We will stop flying as near to 5:00 PM as possible.

There will be a throw-out round after six rounds are flown. Saturday and Sunday flights will both have a 10-minute maximum working time.

The Sunday pilots' meeting will be at 8:30 AM. First group will fly at 9:00 AM. We will stop flying as near 12:00 noon Sunday as possible. 15 minute flyoff rounds will be held after lunch.

FLYING and SCORING SUMMARY: FAI rules, as amended by the F5JUSA Tour will be used.

FAI legal altitude recording devices are mandatory.

Woody Award: for highest total score for rounds flown with sailplane using a built-up wing (composite spar ok, no composite D-box). Pilots may fly rounds of choice with alternate a/c—not counted toward Woody score.
